*Danie Hugo* was Cape Town's premier harbour tug from 1959 until her transfer to Walvis Bay in 1981.

During her time in Cape Town, this fine steam tug undertook thousands of routine harbour operations, as well as several salvage and deep-sea towing operations.

Renowned and most versatile maritime artist Jeremy Day, who sadly passed away earlier this year, built an exquisite, detailed model of the tug (about 1.4 metres). Working between painting commissions, he did painstaking research for the model's accurate design, while his meticulous crafting of the model produced a magnificent artwork.

- a teaching aid,
- a monument to those magnificent steam tugs, their remarkable operations, and their crews, and
